- IV. District and School Meeting Reports/Representatives
 - A. Principal/Staff Report L. Andrews- Student council up and running, campus-wide PBIS lessons have been completed and we will have an upcoming dance party to celebrate. Yolo County Office of Ed has upcoming PBIS training to continue to improve our PBIS program. TK construction goal is to break ground this summer. District has determined to use the land perpendicular to the C-wing. TK and Kinder teams are meeting across the district to discuss playground needs with the Director of Elementary Ed.
 - B. Superintendent's Advisory N. Schroeder Nearly 1 in 5 teachers are paid through parcel tax, but it is also important to be aware that teachers cannot campaign at school. Unlike previous parcel tax measures, this will continue. Strategic fencing has also been discussed. The quality of the fencing may vary by site. Priority sites (that will be first to be fenced in): Davis Senior High School, North Davis, and Willet. Construction will hopefully begin in September 2024. End date TBD.
 - C. ELAC Update L. Andrews- Currently in the reclassification process; TK and Kinder certifications are going out to encourage families to continue to strengthen the "superpower" of bilingualism. We anticipate a February/March reclassification ceremony. A new Multilingual Ed was hired. She will be on campus next week, and there will be some discussion about what our site needs to strengthen our program.

- V. Review CAASPP Data L. Andrews- This information is available online. They are available for all schools. District wide: 46.6% are meeting or exceeding standards in ELA. Math 34.6% in Math. Korematsu: was well above the state average last year. We are staying on pace and still above the state average, but there is room for improvement. Math is an area where we are seeing less growth. This data will be used to determine how we allocate funds and to have conversations with the district. C. Breckenridge Suggests grade levels may be able to use this data to make improvements.
